ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE ARTWORKS PURCHASED FOR THE COLLECTION

On 21 September 2021, the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan Art Museum and Red Location Art Gallery hosted a special exhibition event to celebrate the 28 artists who were finalists in the 2020 call for top Eastern Cape art.

In 2020 the Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality through the Red Location Art Gallery and Nelson Mandela Metropolitan Art Museum called Eastern Cape artists who work and live (or have worked and lived) in the Eastern Cape and have made a significant contribution to the art of the region to submit work for consideration to the Art Collection of the City.

The Art Collection of the Bay tells the story of art in the region and it is important that new and contemporary voices are added to the unique story of art of the Eastern Cape. In 2020 the Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality identified funding for the purchase of works of art as part of the City's initiative to support local art.
