Exhibition tours and art workshops are FREE and are held every: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 09h00 until 11h30. The workshops are developed to make the most of the educational aspects of current exhibitions and are adapted for each grade.

## **SCHOOL LEARNER WORKSHOPS**

### **Objectives:**

- To discover the Art Museum's collection
- To perceive and think through art
- To explore art history
- To understand visual language
- To create with a variety of materials and engage in a variety of art making processes
- To develop learner's appreciation of art



## **TERM 2 : 24 APRIL – 15 JUNE 2023**

### **EXPLORE LINE, SHAPE AND SPACE**

**Objective:** To introduce learners to the basic elements of art (colour, line, shape, and form) and to show learners how artists use these elements in different ways in their work.

#### **Foundation Phase: Grade R – 3**

Activity: Line Drawing & Exploring shapes with pipe cleaners

- Learners will be introduced to the names of different kinds of lines
- Learners will experiment with various materials and tools to explore different types of lines

#### **Intermediate Phase: Grade 4 – 6**

Activity: Create a 3D mini art museum

- Learners will create a 3D mini paper museum by transforming a flat sheet of construction paper into a three-dimensional paper building by using cutting and scoring techniques
- Learners will also create museum display objects

#### **Senior Phase: Grade 7 – 9**

Activity: Draw a museum in a one-point perspective

- Learners will create a one-point perspective drawing of the museum

## **TERM 3 : 20 JULY – 22 SEPTEMBER 2023**

### **EXPLORE COLOUR AND PATTERN**

**Objective:** To experiment with colour mixing and to learn and apply design principle pattern making.

#### **Foundation Phase: Grade R – 3**

Activity: Painting in primary colours

- Learners will learn about primary colours and create colour patterns
- Learners will explore works of art by artists that use primary colours

#### **Intermediate Phase: Grade 4 – 6**

Activity: Painting in warm colours and cool colours

- Learners will explore with colour mixing to create a secondary colour
- Learners will create a painting that portrays warm and cool colours

#### **Senior Phase: Grade 7 – 9**

Activity: Painting in Monochromatic

- Learners will explore with colour mixing to create light and dark shades of colour
- They will create patterns using one colour but different shade variations



## **TERM 4: 12 OCTOBER – 8 DECEMBER 2023**

### **EXPLORE WITH FORM AND TEXTURE**

**Activity:** Explore with clay

**Objective:** To expose learners to clay hand building techniques as well as to work in form. Learners will also gain understanding in the differences between form and shape.

#### **Foundation Phase: Grade R – 3**

**Activity:** Make pinch pot animals

- Learners will work with clay and learn how to create a pinch pot and transform it into an animal

#### **Intermediate Phase: Grade 3 – 6**

**Activity:** Make sculptural Vessels

- Learners will work with clay and learn how to make clay vessels using the coiling and pinching technique and decorate them

#### **Senior Phase: Grade 7 – 9**

**Activity:** Self-portrait sculpture

- Learners will work with clay and learn how to make clay bust sculptures

- ***Booking is essential!!***
- The school workshop programme works on a first come first serve basis.

- A minimum of 10 learners and a maximum of 20 learners can be accommodated in the workshop area.
- Workshops are free and are presented on a Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday during a school term from 09h00 – 11h30.
- Workshops are linked to the Art Museum's Permanent Collection and exhibitions that are on show at the time.
- The booking is only confirmed once you have received written correspondence (a letter is emailed) from the Art Museum.
- The school is to arrange transport to and from the Art Museum.
- Learners are to bring their own packed lunches.
- A school may only book four (4) workshops per term.



## **ART MUSEUM EXHIBITION TOURS**

### **GUIDED EXHIBITION TOURS**
