## **TERM 1: 1 February – 20 March 2024**

### **CREATE IN 2D: EXPLORE LINES, SHAPES, TONE AND COLOUR IN ART**

Activity 1: Drawing with shapes and lines

2: Painting / Drawing in colour

#### **Foundation phase: Grades R – 3**

- Drawing with string
- Draw with simple shapes

#### **Intermediate phase: Grades 4 – 6**

- Expressive line drawing
- Paper Collage

#### **Senior phase: Grades 7 – 9**

- Contour and gestural drawing
- Tonal drawing

## **TERM 2 : 8 April – 14 June 2024**

### **CREATE IN 2D & 3D: EXPLORING SHAPE, FORM, AND SPACE IN ART**

Activity: Drawing and 3D creation

#### **Foundation phase: Grades R – 3**

- Construct 3D forms with paper, card, or recycled material

#### **Intermediate Phase: Grade 4 – 6**

- Construct 3D forms with paper, card, or recycled material
- Perspective drawing

#### **Senior Phase: Grade 7 – 9**

- Construct 3D forms with paper, card, or recycled material
- Perspective drawing

## **TERM 3 : 11 July – 20 September 2024**

### **CREATE IN 2D: EXPLORING PATTERN AND TEXTURE**

Activity: Printmaking and painting

#### **Foundation Phase: Grade R – 3**

- Painting & printmaking using found objects

#### **Intermediate Phase: Grade 4 – 6**

- Painting & printmaking using stencilling

#### **Senior Phase: Grade 7 – 9**

- Mixed media, printing, and painting



## **TERM 4: 3 October – 5 December 2024**

### **EXPLORE MASS & VOLUME**

Activity: Sculpting in clay

#### **Foundation Phase: Grade R – 3**

- Animals in clay

#### **Intermediate Phase: Grade 3 – 6**

- Clay Portraits

#### **Senior Phase: Grade 7 - 9**

- Figures in clay

### **ART WORKSHOP BOOKINGS:**

**Please note:**

- ***Booking is essential!!***
- The school workshop programme works on a first come first serve basis.
- School educators should book a workshop asap on 041 506 2000 or 079 490 0690 or 071 640 3442.
- Workshop themes will be linked to the exhibitions on show.
- A Minimum of 10 learners and a maximum of 20 learners can be accommodated in the workshop area.
- Workshops are free and are presented on a Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday during a school term from 09h00 – 12h00.
- The booking is only confirmed once you have received written correspondence (email/letter) from the Art Museum.
- The school is to arrange transport to and from the Art Museum
- Learners are to bring their own packed lunches.
- A school may only book 4 workshops per term.



## **ART MUSEUM EXHIBITION TOURS**

### **GUIDED EXHIBITION TOURS**

Educational tours of exhibitions are available for class groups. Coordinators or Educators who would like a guided tour for their group can contact the Art Museum to book the tour. Big groups are broken into smaller groups for the guided tours. Booking is essential to ensure a guide is available.

Duration of tours:

- Foundation Phase: 30 minutes
- Intermediate Phase: 45 minutes
- Senior Phase: 60 minutes

### **SELF- GUIDED EXHIBITION TOURS**

Art groups, Coordinators or Educators are welcome to guide their students or group through the Art Museum independently and view the exhibition on their own.

### **SPECIAL REQUEST EXHIBITION TOURS**

We are happy to work with Educators to make a special exhibition tour that meets the needs of the group or class or to create a tour that closely connects to the curriculum. Please email us and provide as much detail as possible on what you require. Please note that tours, focus on the Art Museum's Permanent Collection and exhibitions that are on show at the time.

### **EXHIBITION TOUR BOOKINGS**

- Art museum exhibition tours are available for the community, organizations, universities, colleges and school groups during opening hours.
- The exhibition tours are available throughout the year even during school holidays. Guided tours are available after 12:00 during the school term.
- Entrance is free.

- The exhibition tours work on a first come first serve basis.
- Please note that the booking is only confirmed once you have received written correspondence from the Art Museum.
